

BAC COVID-19 POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

- All dancers need to be dropped off at the door to the studio that their dance class will be held. Prior to entry, dancers will be temperature checked and given hand sanitizer. Any dancer who has a temperature over 100 degrees will not be admitted to class.

- Masks, will be mandatory upon entry and exit from BAC. To help ensure the health and safety of the entire BAC family we ask that if your dancer feels comfortable and safe wearing their masks while dancing, that they do so, especially during the times in classes when social distancing is not possible. Please know that wearing a mask while at BAC, will help us eliminate/reduce the spread of Covid-19 within the BAC family.

- If your dancer is not feeling well, or is awaiting Covid, Flu, Strep or any other test results, we ask that you **do not** bring them to class. We reserve the right to excuse any BAC dancer from class(es) if they are experiencing any covid, cold, flu or allergy type symptoms. If your dancer or anyone in your family has Covid-19 or has any Covid-19 symptoms, we ask that you please follow the CDC guidelines and isolate for a minimum of 5 days. After which if you are asymptomatic or all your symptoms have resolved, you may return to classes but are required to wear a mask and keep your distance to minimize the risk of infecting another dancer. These missed classes may be made up upon return, but please note that BAC tuition is non-refundable. If your dancer is sick or quarantining and will be absent, we ask that you call to notify us. Please know the BAC faculty and staff will be held to the same standards.

- Due to the inherent risks of Covid-19, by participating in classes at BAC, dancers are accepting risk of possible exposure. If any staff and/or dancer at BAC tests positive for Covid-19 we will be required to close the studio for sanitization and testing prior to re-opening. As a dance community, we encourage you all to take daily precautions in order to keep the entire BAC family safe and healthy. Please remember BAC policy states that "All tuition payments are non-refundable. "If the studio must be closed due to positive Covid cases, tuition will not be adjusted, but all classes the dancer has missed may be made up upon the studio re-opening. Please email Ms. Sydney for which classes would be best for your dancer to attend as a make-up.

- All studios have been thoroughly cleaned and disinfected prior to classes beginning. To maintain this level of cleanliness our teachers will disinfect the studio and any equipment at the conclusion of class, to re-set for the next group of dancers.

- It is important that upon arrival your dancer goes directly into the studio. All dance bags and personal items are to be brought into the studio with your dancer during class(es) and are not to be stored in the dressing rooms. To help cut down on clutter, please only bring the items that are essential for the dance classes you will be attending. The dressing rooms should be used for bathroom/changing purposes ONLY.

- Instructors will do their best to adjust curriculum accordingly to help ensure social distancing procedures are taken throughout class time. The faculty will also encourage the wearing of masks during classes, especially during times when social distancing is not possible.

- We love our BAC family, and we are so excited to have our dancers back in the studio, but currently we are not allowing dancers, parents, grandparents, siblings, etc... to congregate in the lobby. Please limit your time in lobby to making payments, and handling office business only. We hope to be able to lift this restriction soon. All tuition can be paid online, mailed in, or dropped off with your dancer. *Please note that checks and cash are the preferred payment option*.

- Dancers must arrive and depart at the scheduled class times. Please make sure your dancers arrive dressed and ready to dance. Remember that, at this time we cannot have dancers hanging out in the lobby, studios or dressing rooms before, between or after classes, so be sure to drop off your dancer no more than 5 minutes prior to your scheduled class time. In the event that your dancer must stay at the studio between classes, dropped off early, or if you will be late for pick up, call the studio to discuss. Be sure to label ALL shoes and personal items including masks.
